Gentle Dental INSTRUCTIONS IV SEDATION

Pre-Sedation (IV)

- FOOD & BEVERAGES: Nothing to eat or drink for 8 hours prior to your appointment with the exception of water and clear fluids (apple juice, tea, coffee, or water, but not alcohol). Stop drinking clear fluids 2 hours prior to your dental procedure.
- **MEDICATIONS**: It is essential to discuss with your dentist whether or not you should take medication(s) you otherwise take on a regular basis.
- **CLOTHING:** Remove nail polish from at least one fingernail on each hand, wear loose casual clothing (ie. Short sleeve shirt), best to leave jewellery at home.
- **SMOKING:** Refrain from smoking prior to treatment.
- TRANSPORTATION: Under no conditions can you drive yourself home. A
 responsible adult (excluding taxi driver) must accompany you home.
- CHANGE IN HEALTH STATUS: If your general health deteriorates
 (ie. cough, cold, fever, etc.) please contact us immediately at #604-371-0801.
- PLEASE ARRIVE 15 MINUTES BEFORE YOUR SCHEDULED APPOINTMENT.

Post-Sedation (IV)

- 24 HOURS: Following sedation, 24 hours may be required for the full effects of the medication to wear off. During this period, it is essential that you follow these instructions.
- **DISCHARGE FROM OFFICE:** You may be discharged into the care of a responsible adult who can accompany you home and remain with you with the balance of the day/night if drowsiness persists.
- TRANSPORTATION: Private automobile transportation from the office is preferred.
- **FOOD & BEVERAGES:** Clear liquids are advised initially, after that, a normal diet should be tolerated. Do not drink alcohol in any form for 24 hours.
- **MEDICATIONS:** Resume normal medications as directed by your dentist after your appointment.
- ACTIVITY RESTRICTIONS: Do not operate motor vehicles, boats, power tools, or machinery for 24 hours or longer if drowsiness or dizziness persists. Do not operate an aircraft for at least 48 hours. Do not sign or enter into any legal contracts for minimum 24 hours.
