Gentle Dental INSTRUCTIONS Post-Root Canal

- You can eat or drink once the freezing wears off, usually 1-2 hours later.
- Discomfort or soreness in the area is normal for a few days to a week.
- To control discomfort, take any pain medication prescribed by the dentist as recommended. **If antibiotics are prescribed, continue to take them until finished as prescribed.
- Even though all signs and symptoms of infection are gone, taking ibuprofen (if you are medically able to take) before the numbness wears off can greatly reduce post-root canal pain.
